Dear Chairman Glazer:

Alcohol Justice (formerly Marin Institute) is a respected alcohol industry watchdog that has been a leading alcohol research and advocacy institution for more than 30 years.

Alcohol Justice is respectfully opposed to AB 400 because it appears to place business interests before public health. The alcohol industry should not be involved – as a sponsor or participant – in events generally held by nonprofits – and never on the grounds of the State Capitol.

Most importantly, we oppose AB 400 because alcohol is no ordinary commodity and California suffers more than \$35 billion dollars in alcohol-related harm and 10,500 alcohol-related deaths annually. If AB 400 is passed and signed into law it could negatively impact public health and safety and increase the potential of alcohol-related problems.

We respectfully request a NO vote on AB 400.
